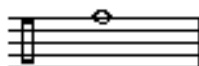

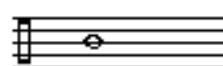

truth and devotion to building a sacred union.

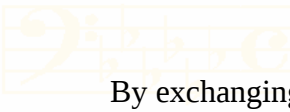
From the moment that we met

faith and certainty that you will be here for me.

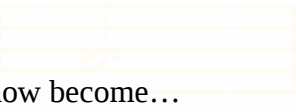
My beloved son,
